You open 1♠ and partner responds 2♣. What is your rebid?

ANSWERS TO 2 over 1 QUIZ

1. 2S default—cannot bid NT with hearts unstopped. Do not have extra values to support clubs at 3 level.
2. 2N—even though you have 4 clubs, you do not have extra values to support clubs at 3 level and you REALLY want to grab the NT to protect your AQ and AQ in red suits.
3. 3H—this shows a 5-5 hand with at least a good 14 HCP (or more).
4. 2D—show your second suit
5. 3D—jump in your second suit. Note the huge difference in strength between this hand and hand #4. Here you are showing a 5-5 hand and extra values.
6. 3NT—this jump shows 15-17 (a hand that could have opened 1NT originally) and guarantees stoppers in all unbid suits.
7. 3C—now you have the extra values to raise partner's suit to the 3 level. Again, you are in a game force so need not be worried that partner will pass.
8. 4S—this shows a solid suit, but denies slam interest (fast arrival).
9. 2NT—this rebid shows EITHER 12-14 HCP OR 18-19. Since you have the latter, you will be making a slam try after partner makes his/her next bid. If you hear 3NT next, you will make quantitative raise to 4NT, showing your 18-19 HCP.
10. 2S—default bid. Does NOT guarantee 6 spades. Cannot raise clubs and cannot bid NT with diamonds wide open.
11. 2S IF you have the agreement that this does NOT show extra values. If you agree that 2S would show extra values, you must rebid 2H (default). Cannot bid NT with clubs unstopped.
12. 2H—default. You can bid 2NT with Qx of clubs if you like living dangerously. It will work out many times.
13. 2H—default. Bidding 3C would show a MUCH better hand than you have.
14. 3C. You have plenty of extra values. Make your high-level reverse showing your second suit.
15. 2S—plenty of time to support diamonds later. For now, continue to bid out your pattern. You have extra values even if partner plays that 2S shows extras.
16. 3S—this is a SPLINTER in support of diamonds.
17. 2H—default. You are not strong enough to show clubs at 3 level.
18. 4C—this is a SPLINTER in support of diamonds.
19. 3D—with 4 card support, a minimum hand is OK to raise to 3 diamonds. You deny ability to splinter.
20. 2H—default. Cannot bid NT with clubs wide open.
21. 2NT—minimum hand. All other suits stopped.
22. 3S—solid suit and slam interest.
23. 4D—SPLINTER in support of hearts.
24. 2S—most descriptive rebid. You really do have 6 cards this time.
25. 2S—most descriptive rebid.
